The second hotel in the Fasano group is the result of a long-awaited dream of bringing this legacy of quality in service to the most privileged location in Rio de Janeiro, one of the most beautiful cities in the world.

Situated on Avenida Vieira Souto, in the heart of Ipanema beach, Hotel Fasano Rio de Janeiro combines the sophistication of Rio's most coveted address with modernity and efficiency in design and service. The hotel is the first project designed entirely from scratch by Philippe Starck. From the 50's and 60's-style furniture to the vintage uniforms designed exclusively for the hotel, everything has been thought out to reverberate the glorious Bossa Nova era, when Ipanema was blossoming into the most charming neighborhood of Rio.

The hotel caters to both leisure and business travelers and offers the latest technology in its accommodations and meeting rooms. Guests can experience Fasano's gastronomic legacy at the elegant Fasano Al Mare restaurant and enjoy signature cocktails and light meals at the 'sceney' Baretto-Londra. The breathtaking view from the rooftop swimming pool overlooks the beach, two Brothers mountain, Arpoador and even the Corcovado.

Envisioned by Phillippe Starck and by Rogerio Fasano, the hotel Fasano Rio de Janeiro is a maze of architectural wonder. Warm earthy tones come together in a variety of materials from all over the world: white marble from Greece, Chinese yellow onyx, 19th century red brick from Argentina, ironwood from northern Brazil.... Upon arrival, guests experience Fasano's personalized service as they are greeted by the friendly staff behind giant, 6-ton certified pekia tree trunk that constitutes the front desk. Towering off-white curtains divide the lobby area into three distinct spaces.

The pool scene is a completely unique experience. The rooftop infinity pool offers an unparalleled panoramic view of Ipanema beach, from the never-before seen angle that engulfs Arpoador, the Two Brothers mountain and even the Corcovado. Many hotel guests forget about the beach when they are up there, and end up spending the whole day between the pool, steam room (which also



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has a view!), fitness center (with one hour complimentary personal trainer), and the pool bar.

There is a wall adorned with a montage of Philippe Starck's ear-shaped mirrors - suitably nicknamed "ears that see" - which reflect the beautiful hues of blue of the ocean, infinity pool and sky.

The menu offers a diverse choice of exotic freshly-squeezed fruit juice combinations (such as fig and coconut water and ginger-infused watermelon juice), fresh coconut water is served in banana-leaf wrappers, cocktails and delicious al fresco dining crafted by chef Paolo Lavezzini (former chef of 3-star Michelin florentine eatery Enoteca Pinchiori).

Guests can appreciate the breathtaking sunrise while enjoying a light breakfast or watch the sun set behind the Two Brothers mountain over drinks. The endless cocktail menu is a great excuse to sip a variety of crafty drinks and caipirinhas - like the apple martini and the 'yellow fruit' caipirinha.

The pool area is an exclusive privilege of hotel guests.
